

Lettera del Presidente

Every student should have the opportunity to discover and develop their own talent, finding the right path to build their future. In 2024, Fondazione Agnelli continued to work toward this goal, helping Italian schools become more effective and more responsive to the real needs of girls and boys engaged in different courses of study. Alongside our work with schools, we also chose to invest in culture as a tool for growth and dialogue, both within and beyond Italy's borders. In a world marked by tension and uncertainty, we believe that mutual understanding and international collaboration are more important than ever.

For this reason, in 2024 the Agnelli Chair of Italian Culture was established at Peking University – one of the most prestigious universities in the world. It is the first chair in China promoted by a European foundation. We inaugurated it last November in the presence of the President of the Italian Republic, Sergio Mattarella, as a genuine cultural bridge between Italy and China. Each semester, internationally renowned scholars will present Italy through its many forms of excellence – from the arts to the sciences – engaging directly with Chinese students. The first holder of the chair was Romano Prodi, whose course on Italian and European economics and politics was highly successful. The project stems from a collaboration with the TOChina Hub at the University of Turin and is managed by the China-Europe Philanthropy Innovation Research Center in Beijing.

In Italy, we strengthened our relationship with schools and teachers, involving more than 1,500 educators in training programs. We believe that teachers must be the drivers of change, especially in the fields of STEM skills and career guidance – two crucial levers to provide more opportunities for our young people.

Among the new initiatives of 2024 is the My KickOff project, which combines sports and education. For the first time, we awarded scholarships to young people with limited resources, giving them the opportunity to study in U.S. colleges thanks to athletic scholarships.

Finally, we continued our research activity on two key topics: early childhood education services, which are essential for building the foundations of learning, and artificial intelligence in schools, where we aim to provide teachers and school leaders with useful analyses and tools.

The 2024 Social Report tells the story of all this: the results achieved, the experiences gained, and the people who made it possible. Above all, it reflects our vision of education — a school system that listens, renews itself, and prepares young people for the future, giving everyone the opportunity to grow and contribute to the good of the country.



A project to give secondary school teachers educational tools and ideas for teaching the scientific method and physics, carrying out engaging and fun experimental activities in the classroom with students. After a one-day training session, teachers receive a kit containing materials on the scientific method, light, pressure and electric charge to experiment with in their classrooms. The project is in collaboration with CERN and INFN, and the support of Stellantis and Intesa Sanpaolo. Active from 2023.


